Introduction

1. This is a countryside property with well used (and in places unmade) footpaths. There is a circular path around the bottom of the mount which is likely to be muddy, wet and uneven in places, especially in winter months as well as access to the inner bailey and the top of the mount
2. There are steep steps up the side of the inner bailey
3. Some of the footpaths are narrow and may be unsuitable for wheelchair users
4. Mobile phone reception is reasonable on most networks. In an emergency, please call the duty ranger on 07824 891420.
5. Dogs are welcome and should be kept on leads at all times.

1. There is public (not NT) parking adjacent to the Mill Hall Arts Centre on Bellingham Lane
2. There is no brown sign. For sat nav, use SS6 7ED
