

## **Dover's Hill Outdoor Property Access Statement**

### **Introduction**

Dover's Hill is an expansive viewpoint on the Cotswold escarpment, including woodland and grassland. It forms a natural amphitheatre on a spur of the Cotswolds, with views over the Vale of Evesham. There is one bridleway which crosses the site and the Cotswold Way also crosses the property, as well as a further two public footpaths. No litter bins are provided on site. Instead, visitors are encouraged to take their litter home with them. Dogs are welcome, however there are no dog waste bins provided. Visitors are asked to take dog waste home with them. As the site is grazed by sheep please keep dogs on a short lead. There is good mobile reception across the site.



### **Arrival & Parking Facilities**

The site is signposted from Kingcombe Lane. There is one formal car park which can be accessed from the lane and holds up to 50 cars. There are no designated disabled parking spaces and as an outdoor site it is not maintained specifically to provide disabled access.

The surface of the car park is compacted limestone, which can be rough and uneven in places. The car park provides good access for limited mobility visitors with a well-worn level grass path leading from the car park through a wheelchair-friendly gate and onto the site up to the viewpoint. The property is level from the car park however it does drop away steeply. Care should be taken near the steep edges.

The terrain on Dover's Hill can be variable, with areas of short grass and longer grass which is more difficult to navigate. Additionally, the site will become slippery

and muddy underfoot when wet. Visitors using all-terrain wheelchairs can follow the compacted grass paths along the top of the escarpment in good, dry weather.

There are several benches which can be used as rest stops along the top of the escarpment. These offer good views across the Vale of Evesham



There is a welcome and orientation board in the car park containing a map of the site and highlighting the public rights of way.
