### Introduction

This countryside property is a mixture of broadleaf woodland, sweet chestnut coppice and open heath. Several flat well-worn sandstone footpaths and permissive paths cross the fenced open heath area, including the serpent trail and Sussex Border path. Suitable for wheelchair and pushchair access. See notice board in car park for more detail. The paths through the wood can be muddy and uneven under foot making them unsuitable for wheelchair or pushchair use. All dogs are welcome including Assistance dogs and are asked to be kept under close control as cattle graze the open common.

**NB** - Mobile phone reception is generally good but can be affected in some parts of Marley dependant on your network. In an emergency, please make contact on the phone number above as soon as you are able.

### Arrival & Parking Facilities

The main car park (Grid Ref = SU88693118) is easily accessed via Marley Lane, Haslemere. There is ample car space and is surfaced with local sandstone. There is currently no charge for parking.

There are no refreshment or toilet facilities available on site.

Marley Common is accessed via several gates. There are no steps along the sandstone paths but some areas have a slight gradient. Marley wood is on the North east slope of the hill so can be steep in parts, muddy and uneven under foot. Not suitable for wheelchairs or pushchairs.
