Introduction

1. Buscot and Coleshill villages are two countryside villages.
2. Buscot village is level with hard standing tarmac paths from the village to the River Thames.
3. Coleshill village is on a hill, the footpaths are across fields and through kissing gates.
4. Both villages have accessible toilets
5. There is a ramp in Coleshill village into the visitor information room.
6. In Buscot National Trust carpark there are 3 allocated disabled parking spaces
7. In Coleshill village there are 2 allocated disabled parking spaces in the Old Carpenters Yard.
8. The mobile phone reception in both villages is intermittent
9. Assistance dogs are welcome and dogs under close control. policy towards dogs

Arrival & Parking Facilities

1. In Buscot village the National Trust visitors carpark is halfway down the village on the right hand side before Buscot Manor Bed and Breakfast.
2. In Coleshill village, there is car parking for 6 vehicles in the Old Carpenters Yard or on the lane around the model farm.

WCs

1. In Buscot village the toilets are next to Buscot Tearoom.
2. In Coleshill villages the toilets are in the Old Carpenters Yard
3. Both village toilets have a disabled toilet and baby change with alarm

Countryside

1. There are 12 walking routes around the estates. All walks are downloadable off our website. Currently none of the walks are accessible for wheelchairs as they contain kissing gates, stiles, footbridges and uneven/muddy terrain across farmland and through woods.
