Pitches

There are 10 tent pitches, 2 campervan spaces, and 2 glamping bell tents.

Prices

Our prices for 2018 are laid out below.

Tent Pitches (minimum stay 1 night)

Per pitch per night - £10

Pitches are mowed but not manicured, and are available on a first come, first served basis.

Campervans (minimum stay 1 night)

Per pitch per night - £20

No electrical hook-up services are provided for campervans; all campers have access to the campsite's toilets and fire pit area.

Bell Tents per night (minimum stay 1 night)

Option 1	£50
Option 2	£60
Option3	£75

Option 1: Tent, zipped in ground sheet and floor matting only

This option is ideal for larger groups who wish to sprawl out or for the seasoned camper who has all their own kit.

Option 2: Tent and zipped in ground sheet with luxury air beds and soft furnishings.

It includes:

- Fleece mattress toppers or throws
- Colourful cushions on each bed
- Bright rag rugs and cosy sheepskin style rugs
- Vintage low central table or trunk

- Fairy lights trailing down the centre pole & one / two battery powered LED lights
- A door mat
- Fire extinguisher
- Airbed pump

Option 3:

All of the above and the following...

- An outside table and chairs
- Double hob gas cooker with grill (please note, cooking is prohibited in the tents)
- Kettle
- Mugs
- Plastic water jug and tumblers
- Cool box
- Water carrier
- Washing bowl
- Cooking table with storage
- Unlimited gas
