Building Four steps to entrance. Narrow hall. Ground floor has steps, small rooms, very limited turning space. Many stairs to other floors

Grounds Two steps from back door down to small terrace, then one step up to gravel path and small lawn

Other features Staff will describe the layout of the rooms and identify furniture, banisters and statues which can be touched. Seats available in the house and garden where plants can also be identified by touch

Other features New audiovisual presentation provides virtual visit to areas of house not otherwise fully accessible

Building 2 steps at Hampstead Grove entrance – ramp available.

Entrance at the bottom of Hampstead Grove has 11 steps – no ramp available. Ground floor – ramp available. Many stairs with handrail to other floors

Grounds Grass and loose gravel paths, some steps, terraces.

Accessible route along upper walk and south garden

Parking in main car park, 150 yards

Accessible toilet in café, reached through café/shop building, in Snuff Mill

Building Level entrance. 2 wheelchairs to borrow, booking essential. Stairs to other floors in Snuff Mill

Grounds Loose gravel paths, partly accessible. Map of accessible route. Some unsurfaced paths

Other features Tactile granite snuff milling stones outside Snuff Mill. Ornamental ironwork on White Bridges. Sounds of rushing water by mill and waterbirds across the park

Café and shop   **Garden**    

Parking free parking for Blue Badge holders. Designated bays in main car park, 400 yards to House. Transfer buggy (not wheelchair accessible) available 12 to 5 Wednesday to Sunday, March to October

Accessible toilet close to stableyard

House 20 steps (with handrail) to principal floor, stairclimber available for external steps; unsuitable for powered or non-standard chairs or if steps are wet. Please contact car park or info point staff on arrival. 2 indoor wheelchairs. Ground floor has steps, uneven floors. Stairs to other floors



Grounds Garden paths level, compacted gravel. Some uneven and muddy paths, slopes, some cobbles. Accessible route.

3 outdoor wheelchairs. Two powered mobility vehicles normally available 1 to 4:30 Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays March to October. No advance booking but please call to check availability

Other features House audiovisual guides feature a signed version and audio only described version of the tour. Most rooms are decorated with fresh flowers and herbs grown on the estate. Film subtitled. Mrs Child's Flower Garden includes beds planted with 18th-century flower varieties, many of which are perfumed

Building Level entrance. Small hallway and cinema on ground floor. Many stairs with handrail to other floors. Introductory video with sound and subtitles. Filmed tour of upper floors viewable on request

Other features The house affords many opportunities to feel architectural details such as door frames, handles, smooth concrete wall surfaces, plus the brass handrail and rope balustrades of our spiral staircase
