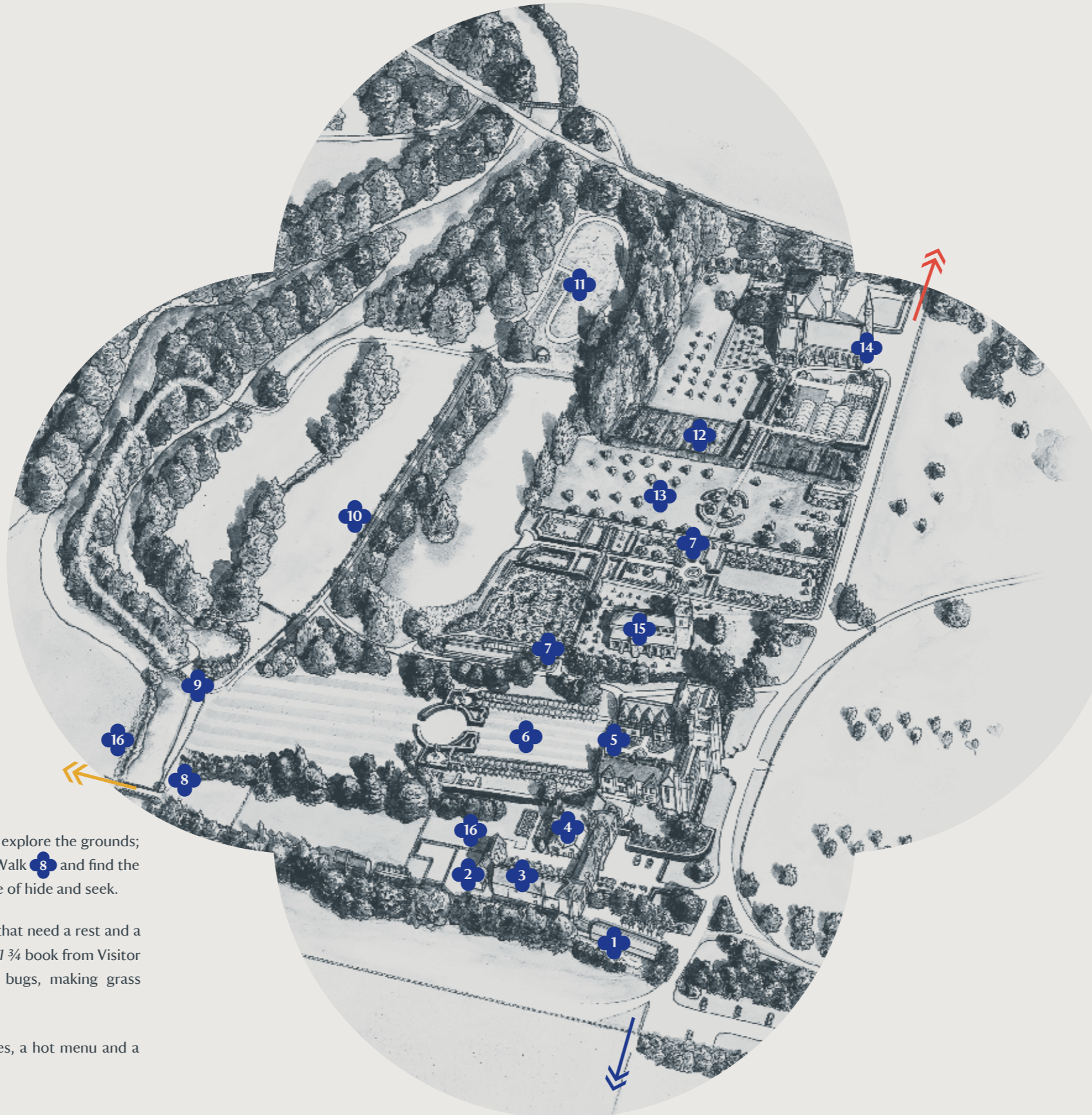
Out for a walk?

Borrow a Nature Card from Visitor Reception to explore the grounds; venture over the bridge to go on the Woodland Walk 8 and find the Grandfather Clock - a great place to start a game of hide and seek.

Try the outdoor games (near the Café for those that need a rest and a cup of tea). Pick up a *50 things to do before you're 11 ¾* book from Visitor Reception and explore the woodland hunting bugs, making grass trumpets or trying to catch a falling leaf.

The Café has children's pick and mix lunch boxes, a hot menu and a microwave for heating little dinners. 4
