What can I see and do?

- Discover the ground floor of the **mansion** from 11am to 4pm, including 'Skin Deep', an exhibition by artist Oliver Jones, in partnership with Meadow Arts.
- Enjoy the **gardens** while following the **one-way systems**. Please follow the signs and have a look at the map inside this leaflet.
- Follow a walk through the **parkland**—the Berrington leaflet contains a walks map with points of interest. You can even visit the den building area whilst you're in the parkland.
- Pop to the **Stables cafe** to enjoy a limited take-away menu (10-4pm).
- Take a seat on one of the benches provided—these are sanitised regularly throughout the day.
- Some areas will be closed, including the play area, parts of the garden, some paths, the bookshop and shop.
- Please help us look after Berrington and put litter in bins provided. Dog waste bins can be found at the start of the walks and in the car park.

- You'll see signs and instructions on your visit today—please follow these carefully
- Please keep 2 metres apart
- Toilets are operating under a one-out one-in system and are checked and sanitised regularly.

Walking in the parkland?


Please keep dogs on leads and under control as there are sheep and cattle grazing. Please close all gates behind you.
