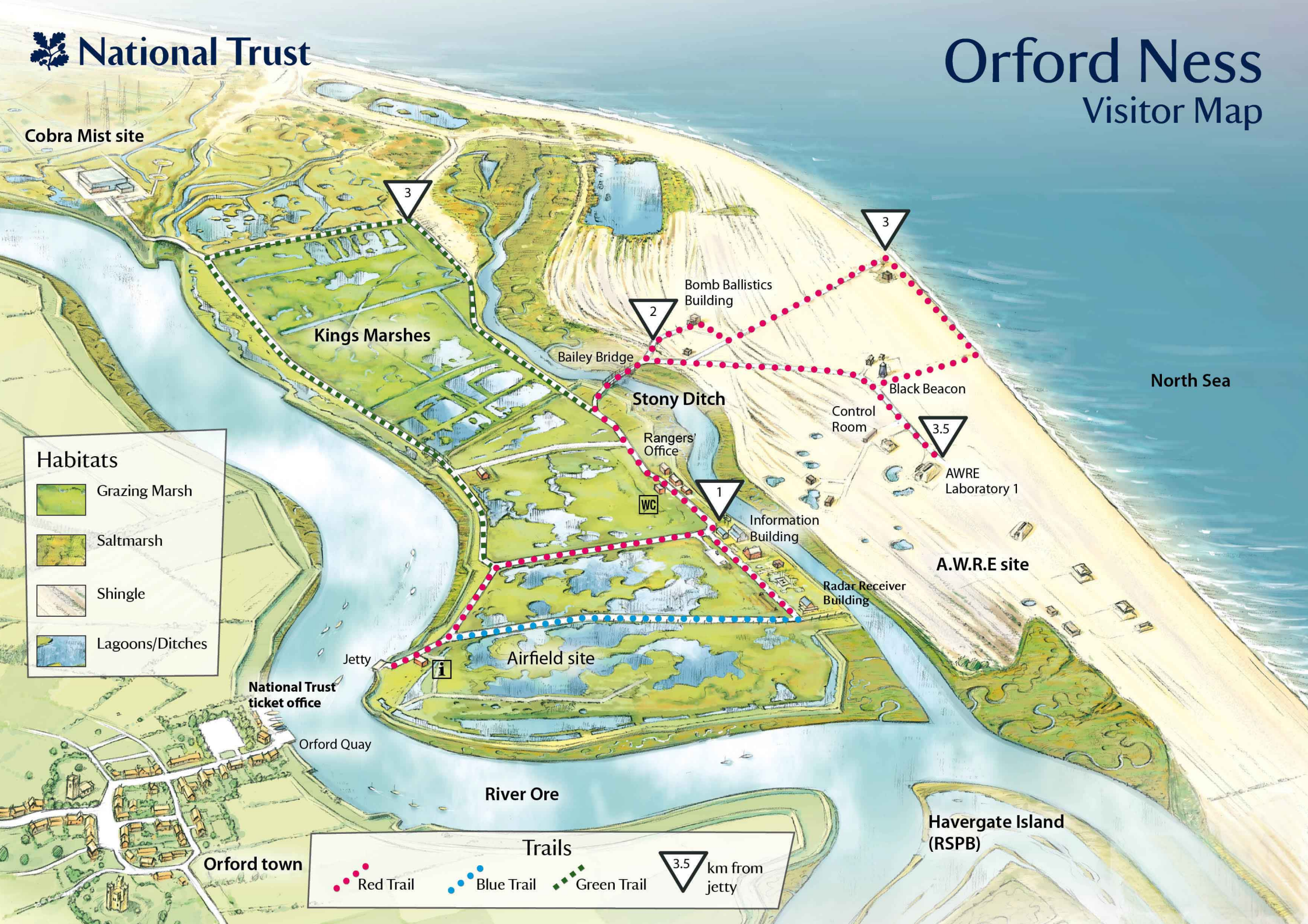

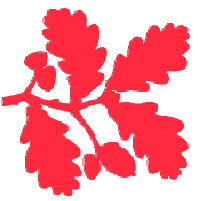

Staying safe on Orford Ness

Please read these notes carefully. They will help to ensure you have a safe and rewarding visit.

The map overleaf shows the way-marked visitor routes. The way-marks can be clearly seen as coloured arrows on the surface of the road or track and on route-marker concrete blocks. Check to see which routes are open as some are only open at selected times. Route information is given at the start of the trails.

Please help us and ensure your safety by keeping to the way-marked routes:

- Very fragile habitats and wildlife can be easily damaged and disturbed
- Any person straying from the visitor routes is at danger from unexploded ordnance. The site has been surface cleared but it is possible for buried ordnance to work its way to the surface.
- Children should be accompanied by an adult whilst on site.
- Do not cross any barriers marked either **NO ENTRY** or **NO ACCESS**
- **The AWRE site (except Lab 1) is strictly out of bounds to all visitors unless otherwise directed (see map)**

In the event of an incident, emergency or severe weather warning it may be necessary to evacuate all or part of the site immediately. On being instructed to evacuate, please proceed to the landing jetty or designated muster area at once. Rangers are on site at all times; they will be pleased to help you. Contact them for help, advice or information and also in the event of an incident or emergency. The Office number is 01394 450900. Please remember the last ferry crossing is at 5pm. Allow time to return to the jetty.
