Heathland

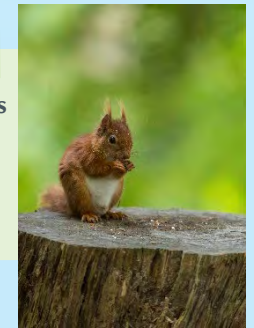
During the warmer months the heathland comes alive with brilliant displays of pinks and purples as the heather come into bloom.
