

# Walks on the Godolphin estate

Godolphin estate is 550 acres of farmland, derelict mining land and open grazing on the hill. Keep to the pathways as the whole area is riddled with pits and shafts.

Many paths are muddy and uneven. Be aware of traffic, as some routes include short sections on busy roads. Leave gates and property as you find them, protect plants and animals and take your litter home.

Cattle on the hill trample the gorse and bracken, allowing a wider variety of plants and wildlife to thrive. Sheep graze in the fields. To protect livestock and wildlife please keep dogs on leads and pick up after them. Cattle can feel threatened by dogs, if you think you may be chased, let go of the lead.
