



Welcome to The Weir Garden

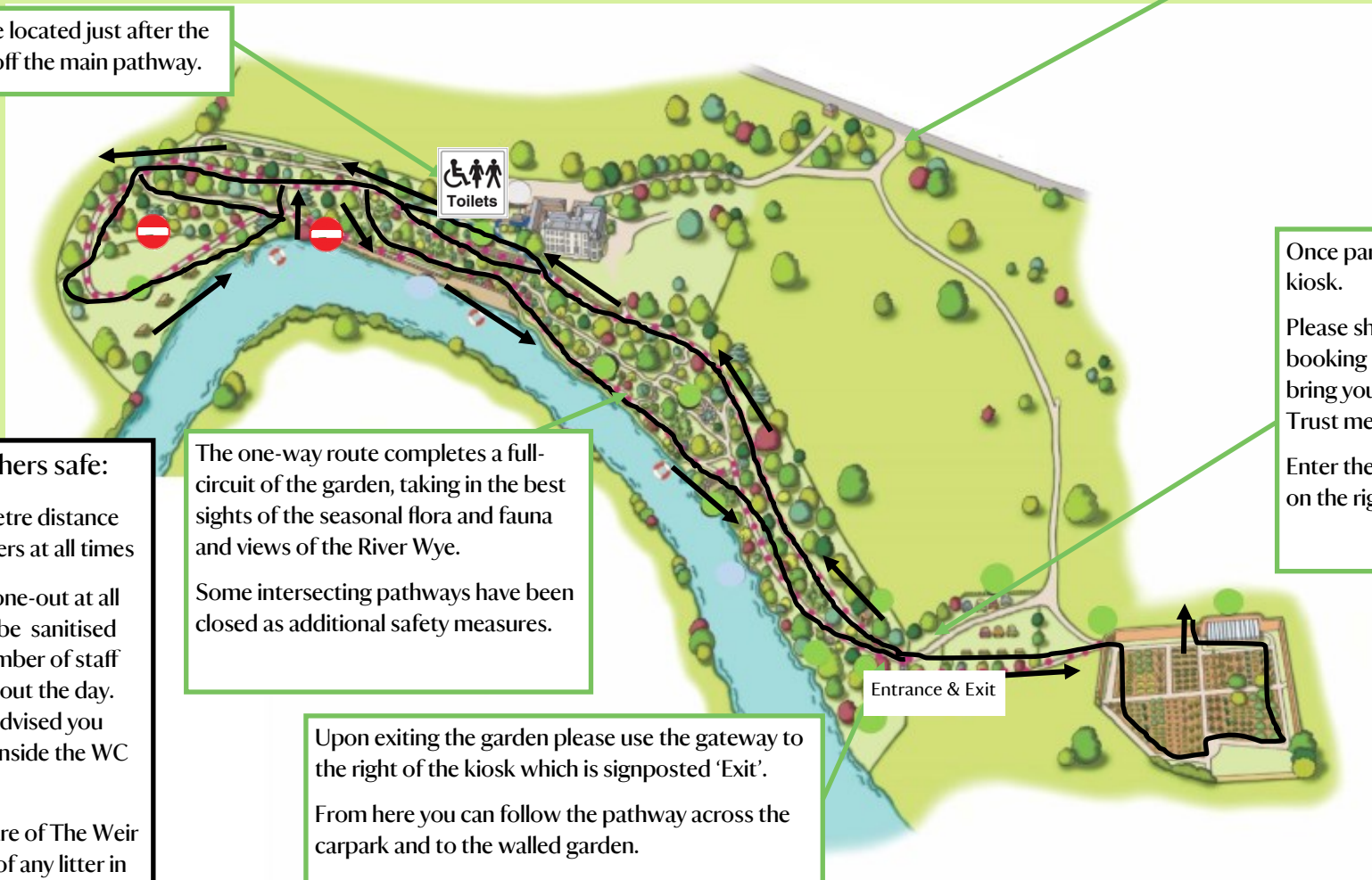
We have introduced a one-way system to keep everyone safe, please use this map for reference.

To keep everyone safe we are not currently taking cash donations.

As you turn off the A438 please follow the left hand drive to the main car park.

The WCs are open and can be located just after the mansion house, turning right off the main pathway.



Once parked head to the welcome kiosk.

Please show your confirmation of booking here and remember to bring your card if you're a National Trust member.

Enter the garden through the gate on the right-hand side.

Keeping yourself and others safe:

- Please keep a two metre distance between you and others at all times
- The WCs are one-in, one-out at all times. The WCs will be sanitised and checked by a member of staff several times throughout the day. Please note it is also advised you wear a face covering inside the WC block
- Please help us take care of The Weir Garden by disposing of any litter in bins provided or by taking it home
- To keep everyone safe, the natural play area, tea tent and second-hand bookshop will remain closed

The one-way route completes a full-circuit of the garden, taking in the best sights of the seasonal flora and fauna and views of the River Wye.

Some intersecting pathways have been closed as additional safety measures.

Upon exiting the garden please use the gateway to the right of the kiosk which is signposted 'Exit'.

From here you can follow the pathway across the carpark and to the walled garden.

In here you can take in the sights and smells of the traditional kitchen garden and see the wonderful seventy-foot long Foster & Pearson glasshouse from the outside.

When you're ready to leave, please use the exit signposted just after the glasshouse.
