Terms and conditions for the Move for trees Challenge 2021 and associated rewards

Definitions:

'Challenge' means the 'Move for Trees' fundraising challenge promoted by the National Trust involving completion by participants of 50km of activity during October 2021

'Closing Date' means 23:59 GMT on Sunday 14 November 2021 which applies for participants to be eligible for Rewards 1 & 2

'Draw' means the draw for the prize

'Participant' means you

'Prize' means £500 (including VAT) National Trust holiday voucher for which T&Cs apply

'Reward 1' means National Trust Running Buff for Participants raising £50 during the Challenge

'Reward 2' means entry into the Draw for the Prize for Participants raising £100 during the Challenge

'Winner' means the winner of the Draw for the Prize

Participation in the Autumn Challenge 2021

- By joining the Challenge you, the Participant, confirm that you've read and accepted these terms and conditions for participating in this Challenge, or that you are the parent/guardian of a participant who is under 18 and give consent for them to participate. You accept the terms and conditions on their behalf and declare them capable of completing the Challenge.
- Participants acknowledge they will take part in and complete the Challenge at locations chosen by them which are safe, suitable, and which Participants are legally allowed to use.
- Participants acknowledge that they take part at their own risk.
- It is not mandatory for Participants to fundraise or make a donation in order to join or complete the Challenge.
- Participants can complete the Challenge with the following activities: Walk, Hike, Run, Wheelchair, Swim, Cycle, Handcycle, Ride, Alpine Ski, Backcountry Ski, Nordic Ski, Roller Ski, Snowboard, Snowshoe, Ice Skate, Kayak, Canoe, Row, Stand Up Paddle, Surf, Inline Skate, Virtual Ride, E-Bike Ride, Virtual Run.
- Due to the Coronavirus pandemic Participants must comply with any rules, regulations, orders, laws, or guidance issued by the Government (including Public Health England) and local authorities.
- The Challenge starts and ends based on each Participant's local time zone.
- Participants are responsible for ensuring they are physically fit and able to take part in the Challenge. Participants are not aware of any medical condition that will prevent participation in this Challenge or will affect their health by participation, or if so, should consult their doctor.
- Participants acknowledge that this is a virtual challenge, and that National Trust will not track or verify results or provide volunteers, marshals, or medical personnel assistance to any Participant.

- Participants' names and other personal details from their sign up to the Challenge will be collected and stored by the National Trust and will be held in accordance with the applicable privacy policy in place at the time [<http://www.nationaltrust.org.uk/features/privacy-policy>].

Fundraising Incentives – Reward 1 & Reward 2

- The Promoter is National Trust, Heelis, Kemble Drive, Swindon, SN2 2NA ('Promoter')
- The start date for the Challenge is 1 October 2021.
- The end date for the Challenge is 31 October 2021.
- To qualify for Reward 1 and Reward 2 you must be a registered Participant of the Challenge and either:
 - Have a JustGiving page set up for 'Move for trees' to raise money for the National Trust and have raised the minimum donation amount as detailed above, on that page by the Closing Date, or
 - Have raised the minimum donation amount, as detailed below, and have sent those funds to National Trust via bank transfer, or at the following address: Move for Trees, National Trust, Heelis, Kemble Drive, Swindon, SN2 2NA, along with your correctly filled in sponsorship form, by the Closing Date
- **To qualify for Reward 1 you must have raised £50 (not including Gift Aid) by the Closing Date**
- **To qualify for Reward 2 and be entered into the Draw for the Prize you must have: raised £100 (not including Gift Aid) by the Closing Date**
- Only fundraised amounts for the Challenge, not one-off or recurring donations, are eligible for rewards.
- Reward 1 is subject to availability
- The exact look of Reward 1 is subject to change from the photograph on the website
- The Promoter reserves the right to change the Rewards at any time
- Reward 1 will be posted second class within 10 days of the Participant reaching the fundraising requirement for Reward 1 to the address provided by the Participant when setting up their JustGiving fundraising page.
- National Trust takes no responsibility or liability for any lost or damaged Reward, replacements may be considered dependant on stock levels.
- Reward 2 will be awarded to the Winner of the Draw by 30 November 2021.

The Prize for Reward 2

- The Prize for the Draw is a National Trust Holidays voucher worth £500 (including VAT). Holidays are subject to availability and do not include any extras. The Winner will be able to pick from the available locations, found on the National Trust Holidays website [<https://www.nationaltrust.org.uk/holidays>]. No cash alternative, other alternative or refund will be given, and the Winner must be over 18.
- Standard terms and conditions of a holiday booking apply see the National Trust website [<https://www.nationaltrust.org.uk/features/holiday-cottage-bunkhouse-and-bothy-terms-and-conditions>]
- Prize to be chosen from the current National Trust Holiday Cottages website [<https://www.nationaltrust.org.uk/holidays>] and cannot be used to purchase National Trust gift cards or vouchers or redeemed against purchases already made. The Prize is not valid for Historic House Hotels bookings.
- The Winner can use the Prize as part payment towards a higher value holiday and pay the balance.

Cont/d

- Holiday must be booked and taken before 1 January 2023.
- If the holiday booked is less than £500 in value this booking will still be deemed full settlement of the Prize and any remaining value cannot be used towards a second break
- The National Trust will not be responsible for any other transport or accommodation costs incurred in the acceptance or fulfilment of the Prize.
- In consideration of being awarded the Prize the Winner may be required to take part in publicity and their name and county may be published on the National Trust website, [in the National Trust Magazine and other National Trust publications]

The Draw

- The Draw for Reward 2 is open to anyone who has taken part in the Challenge in accordance with these terms and conditions including employees and volunteers of the National Trust, their partner and their families who are not involved in processing the Draw.
- Employees of Woods Group Limited are not eligible for entry into the Draw.

- The Draw will be drawn randomly, and the result of the Draw is final.
- If contact with a Participant cannot be made within 15 working days of the Draw Date or the Winner is found not to meet the entry requirements in these Terms and Conditions, the National Trust reserves the right to withdraw the Prize entitlement and to award the Prize to another Participant who will be drawn at random

Limitation of Liability

- Nothing in these terms and conditions shall exclude or limit the liability of National Trust for:
 - a. death or personal injury resulting from negligence;
 - b. fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; or
 - c. any other liability that cannot be excluded or limited by law.
- Subject to the above, liability of National Trust to the Winner shall be limited to the amount of any Prize which is due to that Winner.
- Subject to the above, National Trust shall not be liable:
 - a. to any person for the National Trust's inability to contact you and/or award any Prize or Reward due to any errors or omissions in the details you provide or your failure to update these details if they change;
 - b. for any interest of whatever nature claimed by person in a lost or stolen Reward or Prize;
 - c. any matter beyond the National Trust's reasonable control.

General
