The Peak District Centre is a voluntary association of National Trust Members and Volunteers living in the Peak District. It was formed in 1981 and is affiliated to the National Trust with the aims of supporting the Trust and enhancing the enjoyment of being a member.

We have an event planned for most months of the year consisting of talks, visits and holidays – see the loose page with this leaflet for our current programme.

Any surplus funds generated by these events, and any legacies or donations we receive, are used to support the work of the National Trust in the Peak District.

A diverse range of projects has been funded over the years – from the training of apprentices to heritage trails. In total over £100,000 has been donated
