Introduction

- Located down a private single-track lane with locked gate at the top of the track at the Home Farm entrance.
- Parking for 2 vehicles.
- The Cottage is located at Dinefwr and is a self-catering Cottage: all on ground floor level accommodating up to 2 people: there is 1 bedroom, 1 bathroom.
- It has a wood-burning stove.
- The cottage is located close to the parkland.
- Cariad Cottage is adjacent to Home Farm Farmhouse.

- Bring torch if arriving in dark, as there are no streetlights here.

Approach

From the East:-

Leave M4 at Junction 49. At the motorway roundabout, leave on the Carmarthen exit (A48).

At next roundabout, take the 4th exit to Llandeilo (A476).

Follow this road for several miles passing through Gorslas, Carmel until you reach Fairfach.

At next mini roundabout, take the 1st exit towards Llandeilo (A483).

Follow the road over the bridge, up the hill, pass through the town and take the 3rd left turning (brown signpost marked Parc Dinefwr Park with the National Trust logo)

Follow the road pass the entrance to Dinefwr Park around the bend (White Hart Inn on the right)

On bend take the junction on the left and follow road past Dinefwr Gardens and take next left into Home Farm.

From the West:-

At Carmarthen join the A40 to Llandeilo.

Follow this road for approximately 15 miles.

Before you reach Llandeilo take the right hand turning (brown signpost marked Parc Dinefwr Park with the National Trust logo)

Immediately take the next right on the bend.

Follow road past Dinefwr Gardens and take next left into Home Farm.

From the North:-

From Llandovery take the A40 to Llandeilo for approximately 12 miles.

At the roundabout take the 2nd exit heading to Carmarthen on the A40.

The take the next left turning (brown signpost marked Parc Dinefwr Park with the National Trust logo)

Immediately take the next right on the bend.

Follow road past Dinefwr Gardens and take next left into Home Farm.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

Once in Home Farm, you will see the National Trust wooden gate on the right hand side; this is locked with a combination lock. The combination code is 1930; please relock the gate once through.

Once you have gone through this gate bare to the left and pass through another wooden gate, this one is left open. At the fork in the road take the left hand lane (marked by grey signpost) Follow the track around the garden to Cariad Cottage and park in the parking area on your left in front of the wooden gate. The key safe is on the right hand side of the building and the combination is 1342.

Access is via the front door of the cottage.

Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- The front door has a clear opening width of 1000mm
- 2 steps up to the front door are 50mm and 170mm high

Getting around the cottage

Ground Floor

- The floors are tiled throughout the entire cottage.
- The living room has an area rug and there is a cow hide rug in the dressing room.

Kitchen

- Open plan with living area.
- Wooden worktop 900mm high
- Sink 890mm high to rim
- Electric cooker
- Fridge/freezer, cordless kettle, toaster, microwave, washing machine
- Ceiling lights

Living Room/Dining Area

- Door into from living room into hall 730mm wide
- Three seater sofa, seat height is 450mm
- TV
- Wood burning stove
- Freestanding lamp and ceiling lights
- Side table
- Coat rack
- Wooden dining table is 760mm high with 610mm clear knee space underneath on all side.
- 2 straight back chairs with a seat height of 430mm.

Bathroom (right)

- Door into bathroom is 740mm
- WC, sink, shower
- WC seat height is 420mm
- Sink has pillar taps
- Door into the shower is 510mm wide
- Step into the shower is 230mm high

Bedroom (left)

- Door into bedroom is 740mm wide
- Double bed 650mm high
- Two bedside cabinets with 1 reading lamp
- Dressing table
- Emergency exit door is 1230mm wide

Dressing Room (right)

- Door into dressing room is 740mm wide
- Wardrobe
- Straight back chair with arms. Seat height is 410mm

Garden

- Enclosed grassed lawn with gravelled area
- There is a seating area outside.

Additional Information

- Central heating from bio fuel source
- Wood-burning stove in sitting room
- Assistance and pet dogs are welcome at this cottage
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Please contact us if you have any specific access requirements in this respect.

Facilities at all cottages

The National Trust aims to expand the list of accessible /equipment/items available at each cottage and these may include

- Cordless kettle
- Pillows and protectors (pillow/mattress)
- Chair with armrests and sofas
- Good reading light
- Large handle vegetable peeler
- Easy tin opener
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
- Non-slip place mat
- Easy jar opener
- Information in alternative formats (on request)
