Introduction

- Dairy Cottage is part of a substantial farmhouse that has been converted into holiday cottages.
- It has views over the countryside.
- The cottage has night storage heating, convector heaters and an open fire.
- There are laundry facilities in a communal outbuilding.
- The land immediately around the cottage is reasonably flat.

The Cottage is arranged as follows:

There is a sitting room, kitchen, bathroom and hall on the ground floor. On the first floor there is a bedroom.

Pre-Arrival

- See the main webpage for booking and location details.
- Please contact us prior to booking if you have any specific access requirements.
- Directions provided with booking.
- Please bring a torch.

Approach

- The cottage is approached via country lanes signposted Polruan.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

- Parking is in the communal farmyard car parking area.
- The distance from the car park to the cottage is approximately 20m.
- The car park is sloping and its surface consists of rough uneven gravel.
- The flagged path from the car park is slightly sloping and uneven with 11 steps ranging in height from 19cm to 22cm.
- The key safe is on the left hand side of the door at a height of 138cm ffl (from floor level). It is operated by a combination lock mechanism.
- There is an outside light over the patio area and lighting above the path.



Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- The main door has a clear opening width of 74cm.
- The entrance door leads directly into the kitchen.
- There is a 10cm stone and metal threshold into the kitchen.
- There are no other doors leading outside.



Getting around the cottage

- There is a slightly uneven slate floor in the kitchen and hall.
- There is a vinyl floor covering in the bathroom.
- There is carpet in the sitting room, bedroom and stairs.
- There is a 5 cm step into the sitting room on the ground floor.
- Internal doors clear opening widths range from 67-71cm
- There are 11 stairs with a hand rail leading to the first floor from the hall.



Hall

Ground Floor

Kitchen

- Door from outside, further door to hall.
- The height of worktop is 90cm.
- There is an electric cooker with controls to the front which is 90cm high.
- There is a fridge with ice box, microwave, cordless kettle and toaster.
- There are five ceiling spot lights.
- Views over gardens and countryside.
- There is a washing machine and tumble dryer in the communal laundry room.



Bathroom

- The bathroom is off the hall.
- The bath is standard size and has hand grips on it.
- There is an electric shower over the bath and a shower attachment to the taps.
- The WC is 42cm high.
- The basin is 80cm high.
- Central ceiling light fitting and shaver light.



Sitting Room/Diner

- Door from hall.
- There is a sofa with a seat height of 44cm with cushions and a footstool with a height of 35cm.
- There is a TV and DVD player.
- There is a CD player.
- There are two windows overlooking the gardens.
- There is an open fire.
- There are six wall lights and one table lamp.
- There is a dining table and two chairs
- The table has knee clearance of 67cm. The dining chairs are 42cm high





First Floor

Double Bedroom

- Door from small landing.
- There is a centralised double bed 137cm wide x 190cm long x 55cm high
- The clearance underneath the bed is 4cm.
- There are two bedside tables 68cm high with table lamps.
- There is also a central ceiling light.
- There is a built in wardrobe with a clothes rail at 150cm ffl.
- Chair at height of 48cm.
- There is a chest of drawers measuring 91cm high.
- There is a window with views over the gardens and countryside.





Garden

- The gardens are shared with the other cottages.
- There are gardens to the rear side and front of the cottage which consist of grass, shrubs and bushes.
- There is a patio area with a BBQ, wooden table and fixed bench seating directly outside the cottage.



Laundry Room

- There is a washer dryer, washing machine and tumble dryer in an outbuilding adjoining the Round House next to Fortescue cottage.
- This is approximately 30m from the car park on an uneven sloping grass and gravel path.
- There is a 13cm step into the laundry room and a 6cm threshold. There is a concrete floor.



Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.

Facilities at all cottages

The National Trust aims to expand the list of accessible /equipment/items available at each cottage and these may include

- Cordless kettle
- Hollowfibre bedding
- Chair with armrests
- Good reading light
- Large handle vegetable peeler
- Easy tin opener
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
- Non-slip place mat
- Easy jar opener
- Information in alternative formats (on request)
