Introduction

- Riverside cottage is furnished for 4 people. It is located on the north side of Exmoor near the entrance to the Lorna Doone Valley on the side of Badgworthy Water. It is next to the National Trust Tea Room (Buttery) and near another holiday cottage (Kingfisher)
- The cottage has good lighting and contrast throughout
- There is oil central heating
- Depending on the provider the mobile reception is intermittent. There is no telephone; wifi is available in the cottage

The accommodation comprises the following:

Ground Floor

- Small hallway, an open plan kitchen-living room which has several low beams

First floor

- Two bedrooms: one double, one twin. A shower room with WC

Approach

From the A39 the turn-off to Oare and the Lorna Doone Valley the road is narrow with passing places. To reach the cottage from Oare there is either a narrow hump back bridge (width 7' 6" – 2208cms) or via a ford - subject to water level to cross. If approaching from Brendon the road is also narrow with passing places.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

- There is a small parking area close to the cottage. The surface in the car park is uneven
- From the car park there is level access to the front door on a hard surface walk way. There is a wooden entrance gate
- The key safe is to the right of the front door. It is operated by a spin dial combination lock mechanism. A torch is recommended, especially if arriving in the dark, as the numbers on the lock can be difficult to see
- There are PIR sensor lights covering the entrance walk way

Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- The front door is 700mm wide and has a threshold of 40mm

Getting around the cottage

- Floor coverings are carpet and wood effect tile downstairs and carpets upstairs in the bedrooms. Stine floor and coil matting in entrance area
- Stairs are carpeted
- The internal door widths are a minimum of 700mm wide

Ground floor:

- Level access kitchen-living area


First floor

- Stairs with 12 steps with wooden handrail on right hand side leading to a small landing area
- The treads are 200mm deep
- The bathroom flooring is vinyl wood effect

Open Plan Kitchen and Living Area

Kitchen

- Height of worktop is 910mm from floor level. There are cupboards and drawers beneath the work top
- Breakfast bar with two high stools – seat height 710mm
- Power sockets around the work top
- Stainless steel sink with lever taps
- Electric cooker and a ceramic hob with 4 hot spots. Cooker hood with light
- Stand-alone fridge-freezer – freezer section on top
- Front loading washer-dryer
- Combined light fitting with 3 adjustable spot lights



Living and Dining Area

- 2 x two-seater sofas with seat height 460mm
- 32inch TV connected to Freesat service
- Small 4 foot wooden dining table. Table height is 720mm. Wooden benches – height 450mm

- A bright area with good contrast with 2 x ceiling lamps
- Height of low beams is 1920mm

Twin Bedroom:

- 2 x 3' single beds
- Bed height is 540mm. Firm mattress
- One bedside cabinet (3 drawer) with lamp
- Two over 3 chest of drawers in recessed cupboard. Cupboard has a hanging rail
- A wooden chair – no arm rests
- Low level window with view to the river. Fitted with child protection safety loop and curtains
- Single ceiling light



Twin room

Double Bedroom

- 5' double bed in a central position in the room
- Bed height is 560mm. Firm mattress
- 2 x bedside cabinets (with 3 drawers) each with a lamp
- Chest of drawers with 4 drawers with mirror on top
- Wicker chair with arms
- Stand-alone wardrobe with hanging rail
- Window with view to the river. Fitted with child protection safety loop and curtains
- Single ceiling light
- Angular low beam near doorway



Double bedroom

Shower room:

- Adjustable height electric power shower – 220mm step-in threshold
- Shower has twist controls.
- Hand basin is 830mm from floor level with twist taps
- Mirror and shaver socket
- Toilet seat height 490mm. Press button flush

- Window with roller blind
- Ceiling lights

Garden:

The garden is shared with the National Trust Buttery. There are wooden benches and small tables and chairs about 30m from the front door with level access around the area

Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect
- Mobile telephone signal is very unreliable at Riverside Cottage and depends on your network.

Facilities at all cottages

In addition to the standard equipment and facilities, each cottage is equipped with the following:

- Cordless kettle
- Good reading light
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
- Information in alternative formats (on request)

We aim to provide these items in all cottages but please check when booking as to their availability and to check if new items have been added to the list.

Specialist equipment

Other specialist equipment such as wheelchairs, bath seats, toilet frames etc may be available for loan or purchase from the local Red Cross loan centre. Please check this out before booking the Cottage and contact us if you require further information.
