### Introduction

- South Pilton Green Farmhouse is a modern, bright and airy farmhouse located within walking distance of South Gower's beaches.
- The cottage is attached to the National Trust estate office and is next to working farmland.
- South Pilton Green Farmhouse is a self-catering holiday let accommodating up to 5 people. Laid out on two floors; there are 3 bedrooms (one double, one twin and a single) and 2 bathrooms (downstairs toilet only, family bathroom with shower over bath upstairs).
- There are two allocated parking spaces in the gravel car park outside the cottage and access to an EV charging point.
- It has a wood pellet fired heating system and a wood-burning stove.

- Bring torch if arriving in dark.

## Approach

Leave M4 at Junction 42.

On entering Swansea, pass Sainsburys on left-hand side; remain on main Oystermouth Road, (A4067) following bay, keeping the seafront on your left.

Carry on through several sets of traffic lights. Turn right just after the Woodman pub up Mayals Road (B4436) sign posted to Gower (Bishopston and Pennard)

Pass through the outskirts of the village of Bishopston and into Kittle. Pass the Beaufort Arms pub on your right. Carry on towards Pennard.

Before you reach the village of Pennard, take right turning (B4436) into Vennaway Lane, sign posted to Port Eynon. At next T-junction turn left towards South Gower (A4118)

Pass villages of Parkmill, Penmaen, Nicholaston, Knelston to Scurlage.

At Scurlage turn right sign posted to Rhossili. (B4247)

SPG Farm is 1.4 miles from this point. The road bends around to the left and then further along it bends to the right. The hedges on the side of the road will eventually open up to grassland either side.

On the left in the middle of the grassland is the track to SPG Farm, which is set back from the road. There is a small green National Trust Omega sign at the start of the track. Follow the track into the yard (left hand fork), through a locked gate (combination padlock 1954). The holiday cottage is the last house on your right, please park directly outside the cottage.

## Arrival & Parking Facilities

The key to your cottage will be located in a key safe in the front porch. There are two allocated car parking spaces in the car park outside the cottage.

## Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- The front door has a clear opening width of 710mm
- The porch has an opening width of 1010mm
- The step into the porch is a height of 155mm
- The step outside the front door is a height of 115mm
- Outside and porch lights.

## Getting around the cottage

- The cottage is laid out on two floors.
- There are 7 steps on the staircase then a right-angle turn. There is 1 step then another right-angle turn. There are a further 6 steps to the landing.

- Each step has a height of 200mm.
- The staircase has a width of 700mm.
- The handrail is on the right.
- There are ceiling lights on the landing which illuminate the staircase.
- The floors are carpet in the sitting room, staircase, landing and all three bedrooms. Lino in the hallway and both bathrooms. Ceramic tiles in the kitchen and slate tiles in the porch.

## Ground Floor

### Hallway

- The back door off the hallway has a clear opening width of 780mm.
- The lip inside the back door is a height of 10mm.
- There are two steps outside the back door – one is a height of 130mm, the other 170mm.
- Rush mat outside front door (in porch) and by back door inside.
- Carpet matting inside front door
- Ceiling lights

### Cupboard under stairs

- Door has opening width of 635mm.
- Lip on the door is height of 30mm.
- Door is a height of (from the lip) 1480mm.

### Kitchen

- Door from hallway opening width of 700mm.
- Back door opening width of 770mm.
- Lip on back door inside 55mm.
- Lip on back door outside 30mm.
- Rush mat inside back door.
- Wooden worktops
- Worktop height 930mm.
- Sink height to rim 940mm.
- Lever taps (small levers)
- Fridge/freezer, washing machine, dishwasher, toaster, microwave, cordless kettle.
- Electric cooker and hob
- Radio/hi-fi
- Ceiling lights and lights on units.
- Wooden dining table with six wooden chairs.

- Wooden chair seat height 480mm
- Table top height 775mm
- Knee clearance under table 700mm on the ends, 645mm on the sides.

## Sitting room

- Door into hallway opening width of 700mm
- TV, DVD player
- One arm chair with a seat height of 530mm
- Two two-seater sofas with a seat height between 440 and 460mm
- Standard lamp
- Ceiling and wall lights
- Wood burner

## Downstairs toilet

- WC and sink
- Door from hallway has opening width of 790mm
- WC seat height 420mm
- Sink rim height 810mm
- Lever taps
- Ceiling light and light on mirror

## First Floor

### Bathroom (main)

- WC, sink, bath with shower over
- Door from landing has opening width of 780mm
- WC seat height 410mm
- Sink height 810mm
- Lever taps
- Bath edge height 535mm
- Bath depth inside 330mm
- Ceiling light and light on mirror

### Double bedroom

- Door from landing opening width of 710mm
- Double bed
- Bed height 630mm

- Two bed side tables with two reading lights
- Wardrobe
- Ceiling light

## **Twin bedroom**

- Door from landing opening width of 710mm
- Two single beds
- Bed height 610-620mm
- One bedside table with one table lamp
- Wardrobe
- Chest of drawers
- Ceiling light

## **Single bedroom**

- Door from landing opening width of 710mm
- One single bed
- Bed height 600mm
- Wardrobe
- Chest of drawers
- One table lamp
- Ceiling light

## **Garden**

- There is a small private garden and patio to the rear of the property and outdoor seating to the front.

## **Additional Information**

- Wood pellet fired heating and hot water system
- Wood-burning stove in sitting room
- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Please contact us if you have any specific access requirements in this respect.
