

National Trust Cottages Accessibility Guide Tanner Brow

Introduction

- Tanner Brow is a first floor apartment above a NT tenanted house.
- It is situated in a tiny hamlet comprising 4 other NT tenanted houses.

- The Cottage is arranged as follows:

All on First Floor:

- Entrance into hallway
- Bathroom and dining room accessed from hallway to right
- Access from hallway to kitchen/lounge
- Access to both bedrooms from kitchen/lounge

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Arrival & Parking Facilities

- There is designated parking outside of the property, signed for Tanner Brow. There is room for two vehicles here.



Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- Access is via a wooden staircase comprising 6 wooden steps measuring 220mm high and 980mm wide, giving on to a platform measuring 980mm x 1270mm, and then 1 stone step in to the property measuring 190mm high and 1040mm wide.
- The door frame lip stands 30mm from the floor
- The entrance door is 920mm wide and 1810mm high



Getting around the cottage

First floor:

- All the rooms are on the first floor
- The width of the hallway at its narrowest is 830mm. The main part of it is 930mm wide
- The door to bathroom is 750mm wide
- The door to the dining room is 750mm
- The narrowest part of the kitchen, leading to the lounge area, is 670mm
- The doors to both bedrooms are 730mm wide



Kitchen

- Height of worktop is between 900mm and 930mm with the breakfast bar at 990mm
- The width of the kitchen is 670mm at its narrowest
- The door to the kitchen is 810mm
- The cooker is a standard 600mm wide electric situated in the middle of the run of cabinets to the side of the kitchen

Bathroom

- WC, basin and bath with separate electric shower over bath
- The WC is 410mm high
- Dimensions of bath are 530mm high, 550 width and 1250mm length
- The door is 750mm wide





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Sitting Room

- The lounge is open plan with the kitchen
- The entrance to the lounge is 670mm wide
- There are 2 arm chairs, high backed, with 450mm high seats
- There is 1 sofa with 420mm seat
- Central dimmable light with wall control, 1 side light on table next to sofa
- Open fire in far wall

Dining Room

- The door width to the dining room is 750mm
- The table is 770mm high with 600mm legroom
- The 4 chairs are 450mm high

Twin Bedroom

- The door to the twin bedroom is 730mm wide
- The beds are 500mm high, 960mm wide and 1920mm long
- The gap between beds is 400mm
- There is a bedside table with 1 side lamp
- Small wardrobe with 4 drawers

Double Bedroom

- The door to the double bedroom is 730mm wide
- The bed is 520mm high, 1360mm wide and 1920mm long
- Two x 3 drawer bedside cabinets and 2 side lamps
- Wardrobe with two shelves

Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.

Facilities at all cottages

In addition to the standard equipment and facilities, each cottage is equipped with the following:

- Cordless kettle
- Chair with armrests in living room.
- Good reading light
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
- Information in alternative formats (on request)

We aim to provide these items in all cottages but please check when booking as to their availability and to check if new items have been added to the list.



Specialist equipment

Other specialist equipment such as wheelchairs, bath seats, toilet frames etc may be available for loan or purchase from the local Red Cross loan centre. Please check this out before booking the Cottage and contact us if you require further information.
