Introduction

On the second floor of Fountains Hall, this apartment has oak doors, panelling, polished wood floors and stone mullions, reminiscent of the 16th-century, with furnishings inspired by Lutyens.

The Cottage is arranged as follows:

Ground Floor:

- Entrance door to Fountains Hall, lobby, doors to stairs, utility area with a pay phone

Second Floor:

- 2nd bedroom and doorway, entrance door, hall, open plan lounge, dining and kitchen area, hallway, bathroom and bedroom

Approach

- Fountains Hall is easy to find using the directions provided by the Contact Centre

Arrival & Parking Facilities

- Parking is outside Fountains Hall in the allocated parking space
- The walk from the parking space to the entrance hall for the apartments is approx 100 metres


Getting around the cottage

Ground floor:

- Lobby, utility washing machine and dryer, pay phone and recycling area.
- Flooring - carpet and lino

Second Floor: Flooring- rugs, carpet and lino

Communal door 710mm wide □ 2 x 120mm stone steps

Communal Lobby



- Door to inner hall 780mm wide
- Phone 1250mm high

Utility



Door 620mm wide 490mm high .Work surface and sink 910mm high. Washer and dryer

Stairs to 2nd floor



- 40 steps and hand rail

Second Floor Single bedroom



- Door 790mm wide
- Bed 680mm high
- Bedside table and lamp
- Basin 810mm high
- Armchair 410mm
- Small chest of drawers

Apartment door 760mm wide Inner Hall with storage cupboard

- Door to living area 760mm wide



Lounge area



- Sofa and chair 480mm high
- Side tables and lights
- DVD and TV
- Coffee table

Dining area



Table 700mm and 4 chairs 460mm high

Kitchen



Height of worktop is 910mm. Electric hob and cooker. Fridge with ice box, microwave, toaster and kettle. Door to inner hall 800mm wide



Bathroom



Door is 790mm wide. WC 470mm, basin 820mm and bath 600mm high Shower door is 650mm high and step in is 240mm.

Double Bedroom



- Door 810mm wide
- Bed 760 mm high
- Two bedside tables with two side lights
- Wardrobe and chest of drawers with side light
 - Armchair 380mm high

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.
