Visit the Bears Hut and discover the summer house that Tom the bear moved into.



The herbaceous border is full of flowers. How many colours can you count?



Take a look at the map to find out where you can tick off these 50 things today.



**1. Get to know a tree**

Explore the branches of this tree safely from the ground.



**2. Roll down a really big hill**

The grassy slopes in the garden are a perfect place for this one.



**4. Build a den**

Have a go at building your own den using things you find in the woodland.



**12. Have fun with sticks**

Lay out a twisting and turning trails of sticks to see if your family and friends can follow the trail.



**21. Forage for wild food**

Lots of blackberries grow in the woods on the clump. See if you can find some to pick, but be careful not to prickle your fingers on the brambles.



**24. Go barefoot**

Feel the grass between your toes in the garden.



**28. Climb a huge hill**

Take on the challenge of climbing up the clump Killerton's very own extinct volcano.



**31. Make friends with a bug**

Find the fallen trees and discover which bugs call these their home.



**44. Watch a bird**

Head up to the clump and see what birds you can spot in the woodland today.
