

The **TRIUMPH OF HOPE** *in the Garden at Nymans*

We've selected key plants in the garden that relate to each of the three Messel women whose contribution to the garden's design is examined in the exhibition 'The Triumph of Hope'. The stars mark the areas of the garden where they can be found.





***Rosa 'Debutante'* - found in the Rose Garden**
A charming old variety of rambling rose with a profusion of small cup shaped pink flowers with a light sweet fragrance. It is an ideal plant for a wall, fence, pergola or arch. (Maud)



***Rosa 'Jude the Obscure'* - found in the Rose Garden**
This English shrub rose bred by David Austin has large chalice shaped blooms and a strong fruity scent. The petals are a soft yellow on the inside and a paler yellow on the outside. It forms an upright shrub and is best known for its award winning scent likened to guava and sweet white wine. (Anne)



***Rosa 'Stanwell Perpetual'* - found in the Rose Garden**
This is a charming repeat-flowering wild rose with attractive blush pink flowers of true Old Rose character. It is easy to grow and has a long flowering period. (Maud)



***Rosa 'Madame Alfred Carriere'* - found in the Forecourt Garden**
This is a strong growing climbing rose that bears large, cupped, rather informal, creamy white blooms tinged with pink, which have a strong, sweet fruity fragrance. The growth is bushy and upright with plentiful foliage. (Maud)



***Camellia 'Maud Messel'* - found at the entrance to the Forecourt Garden**
This is a large evergreen multi stemmed shrub with large dark pink flowers in late winter/early spring. Although a slow growing plant, it is quite hardy and will flower for a number of weeks.



***Magnolia 'Anne Rosse'* - found on the Main Lawn**
This hardy medium sized tree flowers white inside with a little pink outside.



***Paeonia 'Anne Rosse'* - found in the Walled Garden**
This is a small tree peony with large papery and flamboyant yellow flowers in late spring. They are long lived hardy shrubs.



***Rhododendron 'Mrs Messel'* - found in the Walled Garden**
This is a large evergreen shrub growing up to 6m with strongly fragrant funnel shaped white flowers, greenish-yellow in the throat. It flowers in late spring. (Maud)



***Antirrhinum 'Madame Butterfly'* - found in the Walled Garden (summer borders)**
This award winning variety is strong growing and vigorous with fully double blooms in a range of colours (Muriel)
