A restored and furnished simple labourer's dwelling, containing artefacts reflecting four centuries of continual occupation, with delightful cottage garden.

The cottage can be visited by a pre-booked guided tour only, telephone bookings can be made up to the day of the visit. Please do not visit the Cottage without booking in advance on 01483 208936. Email bookings can be accepted but must be done 48 hours in advance. A contact telephone number is required when booking.

April–end October Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday plus Bank Holiday Mondays. Guided tours are at 2pm, 3pm and 4pm, with the last tour 3pm in October.
