Package A

Visit us during our normal opening hours of 10-5pm (spring/summer) and 10-4pm (autumn/winter), maximum of four people, including admission/parking costs and use of golf buggy to access all areas of 250 acres of gardens.

*Please note, we would not recommend conducting your shoot at peak times over the weekend due to the number of expected visitors. This package is ideal for weekday bookings.

Package B

Exclusive access to the gardens, a rare opportunity. Starting at 7.30am. We can provide exclusive access to the gardens, monuments and temples before our day visitors arrive. Includes admission/parking costs for six people and use of two golf buggies to access all areas of the 250 acres of gardens.

Changing room available for change of outfits.

Chaperone to escort your group if unfamiliar with the gardens.

We also offer a spring/summer late afternoon shoot from 4pm – 8pm.

This will provide un-interrupted views and vistas, guaranteeing you the very best images possible.

How to pay

Payment is required upon confirmation of booking by ringing our Estate Office on 01280 817156. We accept credit/debit card telephonic payments. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept online bank transfers.

Drone Photography

Drone photography is only permitted outside of normal opening times on provision of pilot's license and public liability insurance (£2m). Permission must be sought at least four weeks prior to shoot.

Weather conditions

We will monitor the weather conditions in the run up to your shoot, should the conditions be inclement, you have the option to re-schedule your shoot. We aim to provide at least one week's advance notice.
