

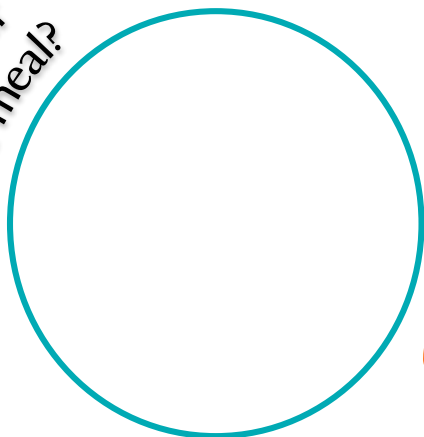
If there was a Museum of You – Age 7 - what would be in it?






